Settling in Action Plan

- 1) Miss Wittman & Parent play together with child
- 2) Miss Wittman play with child, Parent present but not involved.
- 3) Parent physically move away but in sight, no interaction.
- 4) a parent out of sight brieflyb parent tells child "I am popping out" (increase the amount of time).
- 5) Parent says "goodbye"

Interactions:

- I will play alongside the child
- I will copy/ mimic their play
- I will observe their responses
- I will facilitate play by offering alternative resources and/ or solutions
- I will engage in play led by the child
- I will make comments
- I will allow time for a response, when they are ready
- I will be building a trust and connection through warmth, kindness, empathy and validation
